Main campus residence halls are located on the University of Utah's campus. Chapel Glen, Gateway Heights, Sage Point, Officers Circle, and the University Guest House are located within Heritage Commons. Kahlert Village is located on lower campus. When you complete the Housing Application, there is a non-refundable, one-time application fee of \$130. When you reserve a room, there is a \$200 reservation fee that will be put towards your housing account. New students to the University must submit an enrollment deposit prior to applying for housing. **Prices are per person.**

#### RESIDENCE HALL ASSOCIATION DUES - \$66.00 PER YEAR

Dues support the Residence Hall Association (RHA) - a student-led organization that provides programming for residents. Dues are added to your account at the beginning of each semester. Dues are non-refundable.

#### LLC PROGRAMMING FEE - \$34.00 PER YEAR

Living Learning Community and Theme Community members pay an additional \$34 in Programming Dues each year to support activities in these communities.



## 2023 - 2024 ACADEMIC YEAR CONTRACT

**August 1** Students billed for Fall Semester

**August 1-August 18** (pre-occupancy) \$200 Reservation fee forfeited + \$1,500 cancellation fee (\$1,700 total); reversal of August charges for room/dining/services

**August 15-18** Fall Move-In

**August 1-31** 80% of remaining Fall Contract refunded + 80% of your meal cost refunded. Spring fees will not be charged

**September 1-30** 60% of remaining Fall Contract refunded + 60% of your meal cost refunded. Spring fees will not be charged

**October 1-20:** 40% of remaining Fall Contract refunded + 40% of your meal cost refunded. Spring fees will not be charged

**On or after October 21** 0% of remaining Fall Contract refunded + 0% of your meal cost refunded. Spring fees will not be charged

**December 16** Residence Halls Close for Winter Break

**January 1** Students billed for Spring Semester

**January 1-20** 80% of remaining Spring Contract refunded + 80% of your meal cost refunded

**January 5** Spring Only Move-In Day. Residence Halls re-open

**January 21** February 10: 60% of remaining Spring Contract refunded + 60% of your meal cost refunded

**February 11** March 1: 40% of remaining Spring Contract refunded + 40% of your meal cost refunded

**On or after March 2** 0% of remaining Spring Contract refunded + 0% of your meal cost refunded

**May 4** Spring Move-out day

### OFF SEASON

**Early Arrival** (Available August 11 - 14 for fall)

Early arrival housing is only available to students who need to move in early for approved University-sponsored activities or requirements. Contact HRE for more information. You will be charged a daily rate of \$40. There is no meal service during this period. The early arrival date for the spring 2024 semester is January 4, 2024. (Note: not all areas available for early move in.)

**Winter Break Housing** (December 16, 2023 - January 5, 2024)

Chapel Glen, Gateway Heights, Sage Point, and Officers Circle contracts do not include Winter Break housing. Students who need break housing should initiate a request through the room change form to alter their academic year reservation to a building that is open during the break. Kahlert Village and University Guest House residents have an option to opt in or out of Winter Break housing for an additional cost.
